

# **VIU Health Benefits**

# **Eligible Dependents**

### Spouse:

- 1. Legally married husband or wife.
- 2. Opposite sex person to whom you are not married but with whom you have lived with and publicly represented as your spouse for at least one year.
  - Note that there is no waiting period for MSP; there is a 1 year waiting period for Extended Health and Dental.
- 3. Same sex person to whom you are not married but with whom you have lived with and publicly represented as your spouse for at least one year.<sup>ii</sup>
  - Note that there is no waiting period for MSP; there is a 1 year waiting period for Extended Health and Dental.

### **Dependent Children:**

- 1. Any natural child, legally adopted child, stepchild or legal ward (including a sister, brother, niece or nephew if you stand in place of a parent) who is:
  - ✓ Unmarried.
  - ✓ Living with and mainly supported by you.
  - ✓ Under the age of 19 (for MSP) / 21 (for Extended Health / Dental)
  - ✓ Age 19 but less than 25 (for MSP) / 21 but less and 25 (for Extended Health / Dental) **and** in full-time attendance at an accredited school or university.

#### Not Eligible:

- 1. Children under the age of 19 (for MSP) / 21 (for Extended Health / Dental) who become employed on a full-time basis.
- 2. Spouses living separate and apart are not eligible for Extended Health / Dental benefits.
- 3. Divorced spouses.
- 4. Parents / grandparents.

#### Note:

You and your dependent(s) must be covered by a provincial medical / hospital plan in order to be eligible for Extended Health benefits coverage.
